Horry County Sales Tax Dirt Road Paving Program Set to start

CONWAY, SC – RPM Engineers of Myrtle Beach are advising the public that the Horry County Sales Tax for Dirt Roads Paving Program will begin the construction phase within the next two weeks.

For the last several months, RPM Engineers and their consultants have been conducting surveys, designing and acquiring right-of-way easements for phase one of the dirt road paving projects. Today, RPM Engineers announced that Coastal Grading out of Conway has been awarded the contract for the first set of roads to be paved. Those roads include Erics Lane, Shawn Lane and Timrod Lane. Timrod Lane will be the first of 50 roads that will be paved in phase I of the \$19,600,000 dirt road paving program.
